the Feuerstein *Instrumental Enrichment*Program for the Elderly

providing learning and thinking activities to stimulate mental functioning and awareness of the world of familiar and unfamiliar objects and events

enhancing the quality of life by preventing the loss of mental efficiency rehabilitation and restoration of cognitive functions in process of deterioration

What is the Feuerstein Instrumental Enrichment Program?

cognitive exercises using paper and pencil activities that stimulate visual, motor, auditory, and verbal functions group and/or individualized activities: 45 minutes, 2, 3, 4 times per week interactive-- with the "mediator" and among themselves

.....advantages for the Elderly

reinforcing memory by creative repetition stimulating awareness and focusing on their surroundings restoring/enhancing socialization through verbal and active communication creating self awareness and fulfilling autonomy needs

.....advantages for the Care Providers

low initial and ongoing implementation costs
easily implemented in structure of program day
enhances self care and self awareness skills of the elderly
no special facilities needed--learning takes place in the home,
residental setting, day care setting
training and support of program providers (care givers) will
upgrade skills and professional committments

.....advantages for the Care Givers

training to apply program upgrades professional skills changes ways in which caretakers interact with their clients improves awareness of the functional levels of clients widens range of potential functions in caretaking repertoire enhances communication between client and care giver
